<p>WHEN ARE THE EXAMS?</p>	<p>Paper based exams are in June and December each year. Computer based exams for Papers F1, F2 and F3 can be taken at any time during the year.</p>						
<p>WHEN ARE RESULTS RELEASED?</p>	<p>ACCA results are released in February (for December exams) and August (for June exams) each year. Results from computer-based exams are available immediately after the exam has finished.</p>						
<p>WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • High school 'Maturita' (UK equivalent: 2 A levels & 3 GCSEs or equivalent in 5 separate subjects incl. English & Maths) • Mature Study Entry Route is via Foundations in Accountancy • Graduate entry route: relevant degree holders from ACCA accredited institutions may be exempted from up to nine exams within the Fundamentals level & register directly at the Professional level. Non-relevant degrees may also qualify for some exemptions • FIA Diploma exempts students from the first 3 Knowledge papers

For paper-based exams, registrations should be completed before the Exam Entry deadlines below to be eligible for either June or December sittings.
